

Team Eligibility Requirements

- Must be at least nine (9) years old for Shotgun Team and twelve (12) years old for Pistol Team.
- Must be enrolled as a full-time student.
- Must complete and pass Hunter Education Class.
- Must complete all required forms and pay any associated fees.
- Must maintain at least a 2.0 grade point average.
- Must maintain good behavior in school. You represent this team, and all that we stand for.

Scholorship Eligibility Requirements



- Must be an active WBST shooter with the following:
 - Active enrollment in the team for two years.
 - Attendance to 70% of practices.
 - Attendance to 70% of the Teams competitions.
- Must be a high school graduate.
- Must demonstrate acceptance to a 2-year, 4-year, or technical college/university.
- Must have a 2.5 GPA or higher upon graduation.
- Must submit a complete Scholarship Application.
- Must provide an Essay (300 word minimum).

A letter of personal recommendation.

Scholarship Funding



- The WBST Scholarship is funded 100% through our Midway USA Foundation Grant Program
- Throughout the year Midway provides WBST with items to assist in fundraising free of charge. We in return deposit ½ of the funds raised into our endowment account. Midway then matches the funds raised 1:1.
 - Example Raffle of SKB Side by Side Shotgun
 - Shotgun donated by Midway USA
 - 500 Tickets sold at \$10 each
 - \$2500 goes into the team general fund
 - \$2500 goes to Midway, who matches and deposits \$5000 into our endowment fund.
- We may draw 5% of the value of this fund once per year.

The Board determines at beginning of the year the number and value of the scholarships. Any remainder goes into the operating fund.

Equipment Needed - Both Teams



- A safe and serviceable firearm.
- Safety glasses meeting ANSI Z87.1 safety standard.
- Ear protection with a noise reduction rating of 29dB (NRR29).
- Closed toe shoes.

Uniforms / Team SWAG



Your child is required to purchase a uniform shirt and a cap to be worn at competitions.

This year we will set up an online ordering system so that you may purchase direct from the uniform provider!



Required Training



- All WBST Team members must have TN Hunter Safety. This can be obtained a variety of ways, however you must register through the TWRA Website. There is a link on our homepage. Mr. Tilley, who is one of our parents and has said that regardless of the TWRA roster he will get you into that class if you need it. Please place yourself on the TWRA wish list and let us know, we will coordinate with Mr. Tilley.
- Shotgun Team All new shooters must attend Shooting Fundamentals course.
- Pistol Team Classroom exercise is required for all shooters.
- Classes will be announced through the GoogleGroup tool and Facebook / Team Website, and will include the time and place. This training will take place in September.

Application Process



- Applications and fees must be received and processed to the parent organization prior to your child being allowed to shoot.
- Pistol Team Documents are available tonight
- Shotgun Team Documents are available tonight for SCTP (Nationals). TNSCTP will not release prior to Sept 12. We will post all forms through GoogleGroups.




